FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS OF OUR STAFF FOR PARKING - GROUP SCHEDULES WILL BE AVAILABLE ON TUESDAY. Rain date is Thursday, July 19th. Check Remind, or call the office if you are in doubt. Two rainouts will cancel this visiting day. (Reminder: Inter., Sr. and Upper Visiting Day is scheduled for Tuesday, July 24th (rain date is Thursday, July 26th).

NOTE FOR MORNING DROP-OFF: Please do not arrive before 9am, if you are not enrolled in the am extended hours program. Counselor staff does not arrive until 9am, and early drop offs will not be under supervision of their group counselors – we love your child, but we don’t want them to arrive before we can provide proper supervision. NOTE FOR PARENTS at 3:35 PICK-UP TIME: Please do not arrive before 3:30. The driveway opens at 3:30, but some continue to arrive before that time and block the road – history has shown that the neighbors and those driving on Elbow Lane, get upset and call the police when both directions of Elbow Lane are blocked. Our new procedure to get everyone off the street is working, but we need your cooperation so that through traffic can pass before we open the driveway. Using your turn signal helps us manage the traffic flow, please turn it on early. Also, we request that you do not accept or make cell calls, or text once you are in line. Put your car in park once you pull up to the loading station – this is for the safety of campers and staff during the loading process. Thanks again!
